To provide interim relief, GON on date 2076-12-19 (1-April-2020) declared several relief measures targeting Unorganized workers and people with economic hardship depending on daily wage. GON Relief Package for Unorganized Workers

1. Who are entitled for the relief package?

- People working in unorganized areas on the daily wage basis.
- Those who doesn't have any one to look after them or living in temples, church, mosque and other places due to their economic hardship including but not limited to people:
 - Engaged to carry goods from a shop to a customer's house.
 - Construction workers/labors.
 - Selling things in footpaths & streets.
 - Tempo, taxi, Rickshaw driver and their helpers who serve on the daily wage basis.
 - House maid/helpers.
 - Porters
 - Other field workers.

2. Who are responsible to distribute relief package?

Local bodies i.e. Metropolitan city, Sub- metropolitan city, Municipality and Rural Municipalities distribute the relief packages.

3. What are included in the relief package?

Following things are included in the relief package:

- Rice- 30 Kg
 - Pulse- 3 Kg
 - Salt- 2 Packets
 - Oil- 2 liters
 - Soap- 4 Piece
 - Sugar- 2 Kg
- Family of two or less member is entitled to half of the relief package.
 - A family is disqualified to take relief package if a member has any alternative work.
 - Only one member of a family is entitled to take relief package for the entire family.

4. What are the documents needed to take relief?

At least **ONE** of the following documents is required: -

- Copy of the Citizenship Certificate
- Copy of the document supporting economic hardship
- Copy of the Driving License

5. Personal information required to be furnished while taking relief: -

- Full name & Father's name
- Permanent & Temporary address
- Contact details & Work details

6. What if someone obtains relief packages by furnishing fake details or apply multiple times for relief package?

Entitled to pay fine and the government personnel issuing such recommendation are also entitled for punishment as per law.

7. Who take the record of the one who are qualified to take the relief or not?

Respective Ward office.
